## Congratulations!

## Communication

We need to know your thoughts and feelings about your hearing, how it affects your life, and your expectations about the possible solutions.



## Examination

Prior to assessing your hearing, we'll perform an examination of your ears for any physical conditions that might be cause for further medical evaluation.



## Hearing Assessment

Based on the results of your examination, we'll likely perform a variety of hearing tests. Your response to tones, words, and other stimuli will help us quantify your hearing range and capabilities.



## Recommendation

Based on the results of your hearing assessment, we'll recommend the most appropriate course of action and rehabilitation, if needed.



## Hearing Aids

If it is recommended that you wear hearing aids, we'll assist you in making the best choice to suit your needs and budget. Your new hearing aids may be ready the same day or in up to 2 weeks, depending on the style.
