Apple Computer MFi Connectivity

With the latest update to macOS[®] Sonoma, Apple[®] computers* can now connect to MFi hearing aids.

Please follow these steps to connect hearing aids to the Apple computer:

- 1. Click on the Apple icon in the top left corner of the screen and select System Settings. From the System Settings screen, click on Accessibility in the left-hand side of the screen. A new list will appear in the main System Settings screen. Select Hearing Devices.
- **2.** At this point restart the hearing aids to put them into pairing mode. The devices will appear on the main screen. Click the **Connect** button. We recommend turning off Bluetooth[®] on your other Apple devices when initially connecting to your Apple computer to ensure a quick connection.

3. You are now paired with your Apple computer and can change volume and programs, mute the aids and stream audio.

A shortcut can be made for users to have quick and easy access to make volume and program changes to their hearing aids from their desktop. Simply go to System Settings > Control Center and on the main menu find Hearing and turn on Show in Menu Bar. This will provide a shortcut denoted by an ear symbol in the menu bar, which is located at the top of your desktop's screen.
