Safari is also the name of a brand new family of hearing aids including Super Power that offers unique opportunities to children with hearing loss. Safari was designed to improve understanding in complex listening environments and when used with Streamer, to provide wireless access to sounds from many devices including TV, phones, and gaming systems.

Acquiring spoken language is a challenging task because children need to be able to hear words clearly before they can learn to pronounce them. By offering expanded frequency range, Safari can help capture more of the difficult-to-hear sounds that are essential to develop a spoken language.

With a more accurate perception of people and places they can feel more confident and more secure in the kindergarten, at the playground and at home.

Safari's additional bandwidth provides additional high frequency information that could not be amplified in previous generations of hearing instruments. This can also improve their own pronunciation when it's the child's turn to talk.



Streamer

The Streamer helps children to use mobile phones just as easily as everyone else. All they have to do is press a button on the Streamer to get the signal sent wirelessly, straight into BOTH ears.

The ConnectLine TV adaptor helps children follow the action without any delay time and at normal volume levels, so family and friends can enjoy it together!

Children with hearing loss have a shorter listening range or "listening bubble" than children with normal hearing. Safari helps to widen this by capturing sounds from longer distances. But, when a teacher, coach or parent is moving around a lot, and the environment is noisy or very open, it's time for an extra boost with FM.

Oticon's Amigo FM solutions help to overcome problems with noise and distance by picking up the teacher's voice and sending it directly

to your child's ears. With a small FM

receiver clipped onto Safari - or the Amigo Arc a smart neckloop receiver - they'll be able to keep their eye on the ball and their ears on the coach without giving it a second thought!
